

North Coast Region Women's Seminar

During the third week of April, the Women's Committee of the North Coast district hosted a seminar for women throughout their district. More than 110 women from 5 parishes attended the seminar, which was held at Kakoneni congregation in Malindi Parish.

Over the course of four days the women learned about human rights, women's economic empowerment, tips for successfully managing a project, leadership skills, stewardship, and health.

Many women in the North Coast region suffer for lack of opportunity and resources. In this seminar, the women were able to learn how to stand-up for their basic human rights, where to look for support and resource to start a business, and how to aid one another in developing their communities and church congregations. The seminar organizers invited facilitators from Nairobi and Mombasa and engaged experts within KELC and from other sectors. The diversity of presenters showed the women many different viewpoints and perspectives on each of the topics.

By the end of the seminar, the women were tired, but excited to go home and implement some of their new knowledge. Many of the women planned to try small business ventures, and others had ideas of how to strengthen the women's committee in their home congregation. All of the women requested more seminars in the future, so that they can build on what they learned in this seminar.

The gathering ended with a choir competition, with each parish showcasing their singing talents. We are grateful to God for these dedicated women of our church, and we pray they will continue to learn and develop their talents.
