Food Support at the Voi Orphan Project

The Voi Orphan Project is continuing to grow and develop. In the last year, they have increased the number of orphans supported from 50 to 65. The leadership is continuing to identify different methods to support the children and guardians. This month they organized a food distribution to assist the orphans and their guardians.

Voi has been suffering through an extended period of drought. Without significant rainfall since last year, many people are struggling to produce food in their farms and are having trouble obtaining enough food to feed their families. The food distribution this month was implemented to help relieve some of the stress felt during the extended drought. During the food distribution, each child in the Orphan Project received 25kg of maize flour, 10kg of beans, 3 liters of cooking oil, and 1kg of salt.

We are thankful for this temporary relief for struggling families and we continue to pray for the rains to come to Voi and all drought-stricken areas of East Africa.

Voi Bible School Evangelist Education

This month the evangelist students at Voi Bible School began their final terms in their three-year program. Eight students from 7 different parish and mission areas of KELC have been in Voi for the last 3 years while they attend classes to be trained as evangelists. At the end of November, they will graduate and then return to their parish or mission area to begin a probationary period before being installed as an evangelist.

We are grateful for this important ministry of our church and for the dedicated students and faculty. Throughout the 3 years the students have received instruction from Rev. Agnes Chomba, Rev. Manase Mkofira, and Rev. Dominic Nyambisa, as well as many guest lecturers.

Please join us in praying for the students and faculty as they complete their studies and final exams in the next months. We pray for God's guidance and support during this important time in the education of these future church workers.
